

Common Medication Doses

Based on 1000# body weight

Banamine – use for colic / fever over 101 f / Muscle cramping

- 10cc = 500mg given IM or IV
- Not more often than every 12 hours

Dexamethasone – use for hives / allergic reaction / snakebite

- 5cc = 20mg given IM or IV
- Given once daily to effect

Xylazine – use for colic pain / tranquilizer

- 2cc given IV: repeat as needed
- 3cc given IM

Bute – use for lameness / for colic if no Banamine available / FEVER

- 1-2 grams given orally
- Give 1 -2 times daily to effect

Mylanta – use for crampy colic

- One pint orally 1-2 times daily

KAOPECTATE – 8 OUNCES 4 TO 6 TIMES DAILY

- SMZ /TMP antibiotic pills 960mg – for
- Infection – 12 pills twice daily
- Minimum 5 days

CIPRO 500 MG – ANTIBIOTIC - 5 TABLETS ONCE DAILY – WATCH FOR DIARRHEA

GENTOCIN – ANTIBIOTIC – 30CC IV ONCE DAILY – 5 DAYS
